【Full membership fee】 Starts at 250,000 yen per unit

Full membership is for private enterprises, or other organizations, that will participate in the operation of KMK provide support for projects, and have the right to vote at general meetings.

【Associate membership fee】 Starts at 120,000 yen per unit for organizations or 10,000 yen per unit for individuals.

Associate membership is for organizations, such as those related to the arts and culture, government bodies, incorporated foundations or schools, or individuals who will support KMK projects and can participate in them by making use of special expertise, but will not have the right to vote at general meetings.
